For 33 years, he was the creator, showrunner and host of the American television, promoting kindness and speaking openly about children's emotional and physical concerns. Rogers won the hearts of many people. He also earned honorary degrees and awards, including the Presidential Medal of Freedom and a Lifetime Achievement Emmy. Was there anything this man couldn't do? Read on to learn more about the legacy of everyone's beloved "neighbor," Mr. Rogers. He Hated TV, So He Changed ItWhen Rogers turned on the television, he often saw violence and people demeaning each other. The inhumanity made him furious, so he decided to inspire change in the medium, believing there was a way to "nurture" viewers with a charming and gentle program. As a result, he created Mister Rogers' Neighborhood to spread knowledge and kindness. The show's production and sets were basic, but that didn't stop it from becoming groundbreaking television. One of his fans is Michael Keaton, who ended up hosting a lovely Mr. Rogers documentary called It's You I Like. Koko, the Stanford-educated gorilla who knew 2,000 English words and 1,000 words in American Sign Language, loved him too. When Rogers met her, she instantly welcomed him with open arms and took off his shoes (the same way he does on the show). He Personally Responded to Every Letter from FansRogers' daily routine included waking up at five every morning, praying, writing, studying, exercising and replying to all his fan mail. The show's program assistant, Heather Arnet, told the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette, "He respected the kids who wrote them. He never thought about throwing out a drawings and ramblings. Many children opened up to him about their personal issues, such as a loss in the family or other serious problems. Each day, Rogers received 50 to 100 letters from fans, and he wrote back to each one. Today, the Fred Rogers Center in Latrobe, Pennsylvania, holds almost 1 million of those letters. He Was a Gifted MusicianAfter attending Dartmouth College for one year, Rogers transferred to Rollins College. He graduated magna cum laude with a degree in music. As a talented songwriter, he created all the tunes for Mister Rogers' Neighborhood, which is more than 200 songs. He also played the piano magnificently, and it shows in each episode. Photo Courtesy: WQED/IMDb Rogers created music at a young age, even after getting bullied. When he was a child, life was tough He was shy and overweight, and his classmates teased him. "I used to cry to myself when I was alone. And I would cry through my fingers and make up songs on the piano," recalled Rogers. He Saved Public Television and the VCRIn 1969, Rogers went to Washington D.C. to help stop budget cuts for public television. He presented his case in front of the Senate, explaining how he could help children. "I feel that if we in public television can only make it clear that feelings are mentionable and manageable, we will have done a great service for mental health," Rogers explained to the Senate. He did more than just stop the budget cuts by the end of the hearing. Within six minutes, he convinced the committee to provide \$22 million in funding for public TV. However, Rogers influenced the outcome, arguing that it was important for parents to be able to record children's programs and watch them at more fitting times as a family. He Cared Deeply About OthersFrom 1968 to 2001, Rogers made sure to use his show for good. Focusing on children's emotional and physical struggles, he included many personal topics because he cared about his audience's needs, concerns and happiness. He answered questions about everything from scary haircuts to fights with siblings to divorce and war. He also worked with a child psychologist for 30 years. Many people found Rogers caring, including reporters and limo drivers. During interviews, he asked reporters questions about their lives and got to know them. It wasn't uncommon for him to call them every once in a while to keep in touch. He did the same to one of his limo drivers. During one of the rides, the driver mentioned they were passing his house. Wanting to meet the driver's family, Rogers asked if they could stop by. If you figure the average cost of a special drink like a pumpkin spice latte is about \$5.00, that is only 40 cups and if you go almost every day, you can break the bank just buying coffee. This is exactly why I decided on getting the Mr. Coffee Café Barista Espresso and Cappuccino Maker to use at home. Like me, you probably want one that will make your favorite coffee just like the barista at your café makes it but you may only have \$200 to spend. If that's the case then this article is for you so you can decide on the best pump espresso machine under \$200. After I bought Mr. Coffee Café Barista espresso machine, I decided to see how long it would for it to pay for itself so I put the money I would have spent at the café in a jar every time I made myself my favorite cappuccino. It only took two months! I kept doing that and in a year I had enough to go on vacation to Hawaii. Let me tell you why I decided to buy this particular coffee maker and then choose it as the best pump espresso machine under \$200. The biggest thing that influenced me was watching some videos on how easy it was to use and how I could enjoy gourmet cappuccinos from the comfort of my home without unnecessary trips to the café. Besides that, I have had Mr Coffee coffee makers that have lasted me for years and the company has a great reputation of standing behind their products. While it makes more espresso related drinks, the quality may not match what you get from the coffee shop. However, combining the best skills learned from the videos made sure that I got the most out of the portafilter. Before getting to the full review, here is a video reviewing the coffee brewer together with a tutorial on how to use it. The Automated Milk Frother Feature Another feature about Mr Coffee Café Barista is that it automatically does milk frothing. You don't have to stand there and hold the steam wand in the milk to make a cappuccino. You just fill it and let the Café Barista determine how much is needed and then return the unused portion to the refrigerator. There is a dial for the frother which I use to control the amount of foam I need in my cappuccino. The higher end of the froth spectrum is meant for the cappuccinos while the opposite suits the lattes. After using the milk, it's advisable to return the remaining amount in the fridge for preservation. The good thing is that you can use the reservoir to store the milk and fill it when you need more. One-Touch Controls It has a one-touch control panel where you can choose either single or double shot simply by pressing the button one or two times. Everything is programmed in for an espresso, cappuccino or latte. If you push and hold the espresso button, you will enter the custom mode. That tells the machine to continue drawing water from the removable tank and push it via the filters. Once enough, push the button again to stop. The latte and cappuccino buttons can also function the same. The only difference here is that long pressing them will activate the cleaning cycle (for the steam wand) or manual frothing. Coarse Grounds for the Portafilter that allows you to pull single or double shots by choosing the right filter for what you need. You can use the fine grounds for espresso, but superfine is not suitable for the machine. Using finer grounds leads to filter clogging and frequent cleaning. You will not be able to get the full coffee flavor when the filters are subjected to such conditions. you need is a dedicated burr grinder and a tamper that can add at least 30lbs of pressure on the grounds before fixing the porta on the brewing machine. If you are asking if you can use the pods here, there is no room for that here. I have seen some customers saying that there is a pod attachment for this machine which you have to buy separately. I do not need the pods with this machine, but if you want, then you can search for the attachment online. Brewing Pressure The Café Barista Espresso and Cappuccino Maker gives you 15 bars of pressure for fabulous results. If you're not sure what that means, a single bar of pressure is one unit of atmosphere pressure. That pressure for an espresso shot, you need at least 8 bars of pressure. The pump also allows two different temperatures—one for brewing and one for steaming, which gives you a continuous supply of steamed water for drinks like cappuccinos. The industry standard is 9 bars of pressure to make perfect amount of pressure to make perfect crema. Flaws But Not Deal Breakers At times, Mr Coffee is known to produce some weak tasting coffee, but that is something you can solve by just following the included manual. Before using it, it is necessary for you to prime the brewer so that it can always reach the desired espresso temperatures. You can check for the steps on page 8 of the manual. As for the froth, apart from the settings, you also need the right milk to give you the best foam. Still, for better results, you also need to take time and clean the machine. That means running cycle to clean the vinegar odor out. I like to use a full water tank for that. For both reservoirs (milk and water tank), they are dishwasher safe. To conclude on Mr Coffee's matter, you don't need to have Barista knowledge to create custom coffee drinks just like the café does that you've been going to. A recipe book comes with it to make other special drinks like cafe mochas, toffee lattes, espresso martinis, or caramel cappuccinos.
